de Zordo Estate Scholarships: \$2,500 awarded to two students for use during the 2009-10 academic year (ends June 30, 2010). All unused scholarship tuition reverts to the de Zordo Estate Scholarship Fund. Merit based award.

Eligibility Requirements:

- o Enrollment in at least three Gage classes or workshops or a Gage Atelier during past year.
- o Minimum 18 years old up to maximum 35 years old on September 14, 2009. (Date of birth must be after September 14, 1973 and before September 15, 1991.)

Wright Foundation Scholarships: \$2,500 awarded to a student for use during the 2009-10 academic year (ends June 30, 2010). All unused scholarship tuition reverts to the Wright Foundation For The Arts Scholarship Fund at Gage. Merit based award.

Eligibility Requirements:

- o US Citizen – please provide proof of citizenship (in addition to below)
- o Minimum 17 years old up to maximum 27 years old on September 14, 2009. (Date of birth must be after September 14, 1981 and before September 15, 1992.)

Puget Sound Group of NW Painters Scholarships: \$2,000 awarded to two atelier students for use during the 2009-10 academic year (ends June 30, 2010). All unused atelier scholarship tuition reverts to the PSGNWP Scholarship Fund. Merit plus need based award.

Eligibility Requirements:

- o Enrolled in a Gage Atelier Program for 2009-10
- o Minimum 16 years old on September 14, 2009. (Date of birth must be on or before September 14, 1993.)
- o Submission of front page of filed 2008 income tax form (in addition to below)

Your application will be compiled into three 3-ring binders to be distributed to members of an outside jury of art professionals. For this reason, all submitted materials must be printed on 8-½" x 11" sheets of paper and 3-hole punched. Exception: work samples on CD. Please include three copies of each of the following. :

1. **This cover sheet:** completed with all requested information.
2. **A copy of your driver's license** or other government-issued photo ID showing your date of birth. (This will NOT be distributed to members of the jury – one copy is sufficient.)
3. **Work Samples:** Please include ten images of recent work in CD format. Please also include a full-color thumbnail printout of all work, listing titles and media.
4. **Personal Artist Statement:** One page only, 12 point font, double spaced. Please describe yourself and your artwork. What are your personal and artistic goals? How can Gage Academy of Art help you accomplish your goals?
5. **Two Letters of Recommendation:** Please attach one letter of recommendation from a Gage instructor with whom you have studied during the previous academic year **AND** one letter of recommendation from an art professional who is familiar with you and your work.

*Gage reserves the right to change any final scholarship award based on more or less funds available or number of qualified applicants. Scholarship students may win more than one award annually and may reapply for any scholarship award previously won.
