



## **Gage Academy of Art Code of Conduct**

The Gage Academy of Art is a community of students and professionals (instructors, models, and staff). All persons are asked to act in a professional, respectful, courteous and civil manner.

To ensure that Gage is a comfortable, safe, and secure place to engage in artistic pursuits, the following are not permitted on premises:

- Consuming alcohol (except at Gage-hosted events)
- Smoking, illegal drug use, and possession of weapons
- Theft
- Sexual harassment of any nature, including verbal harassment
- Cell phone use in a classroom or talking loudly on a cell phone outside a classroom
- Using toxic materials
- Animals other than service dogs
- Unsafe or disruptive behavior (disturbing or interrupting the orderly course of instructing or performing art)
- Threatening others physically or verbally
- Acting unreasonably and interfering with others' use of the facility
- Damaging Gage equipment or property, including graffiti
- Loitering in the building or on the grounds of Gage

Anyone not complying with the Gage Academy of Art Code of Conduct will be asked to leave the Gage premises and may be barred from future access to Gage facilities and programs.
